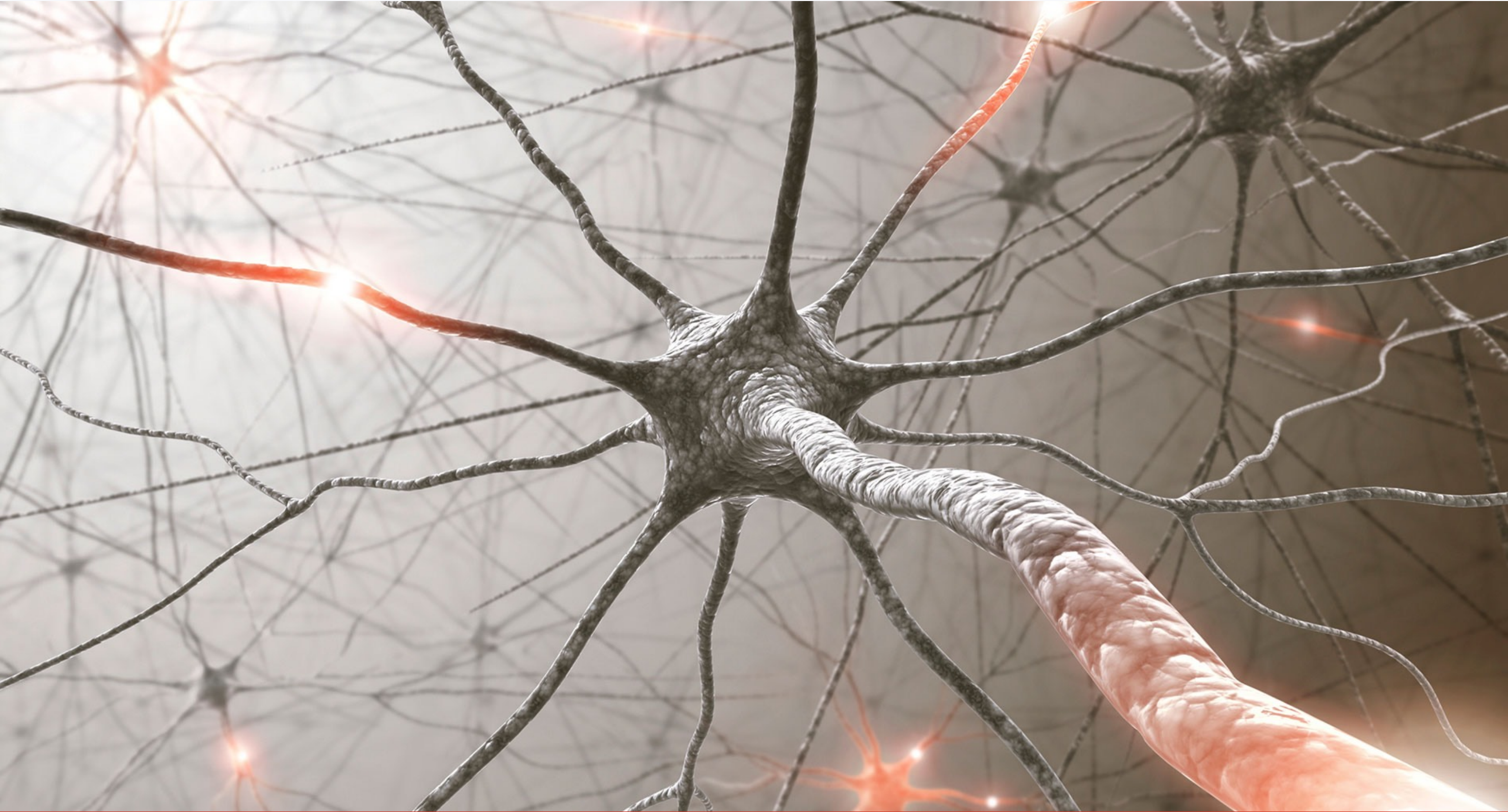

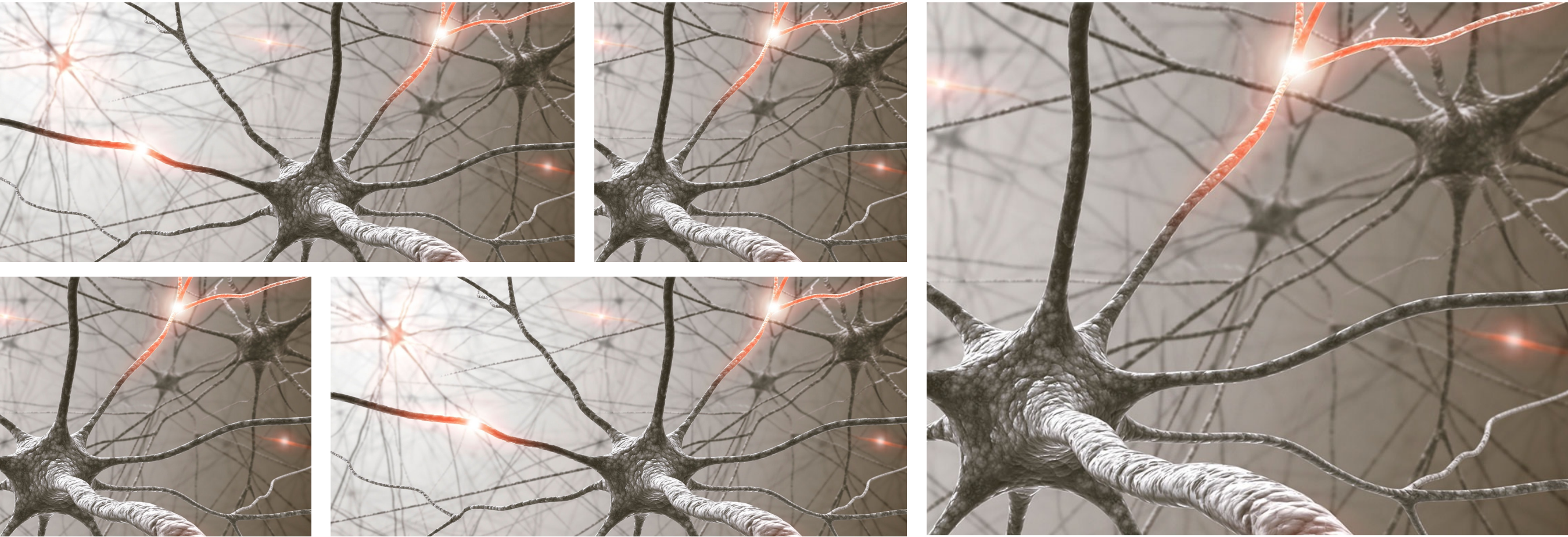

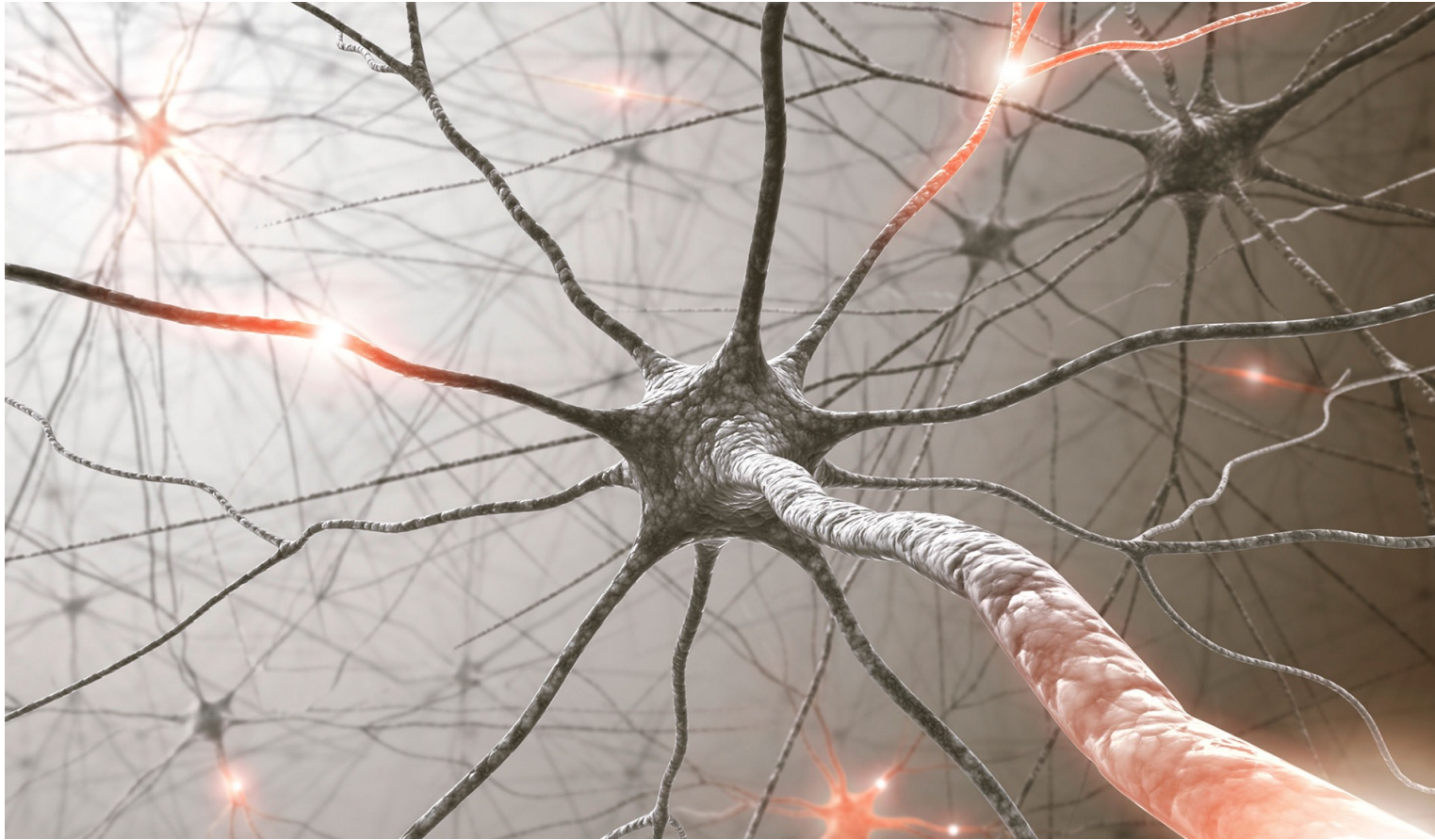
accelerating key clean energy technology innovations.

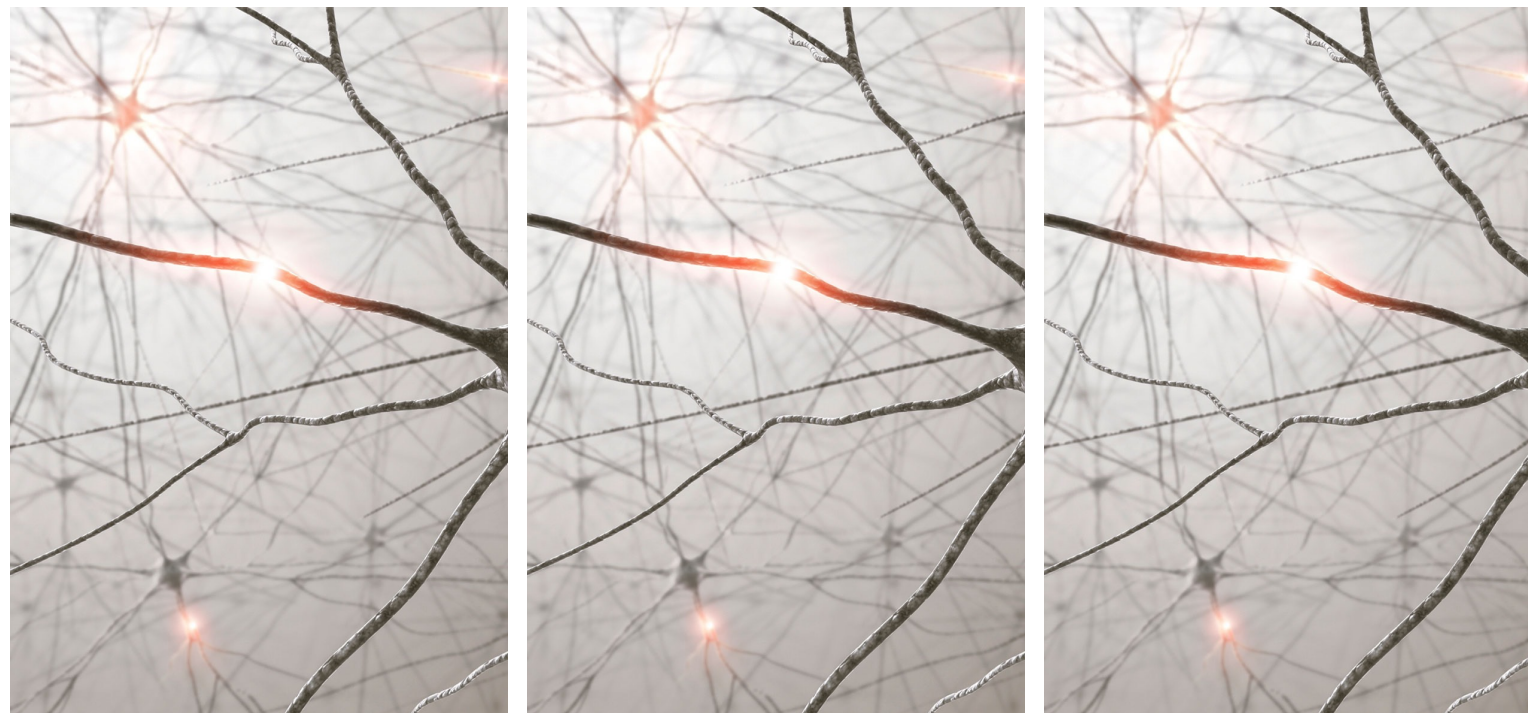

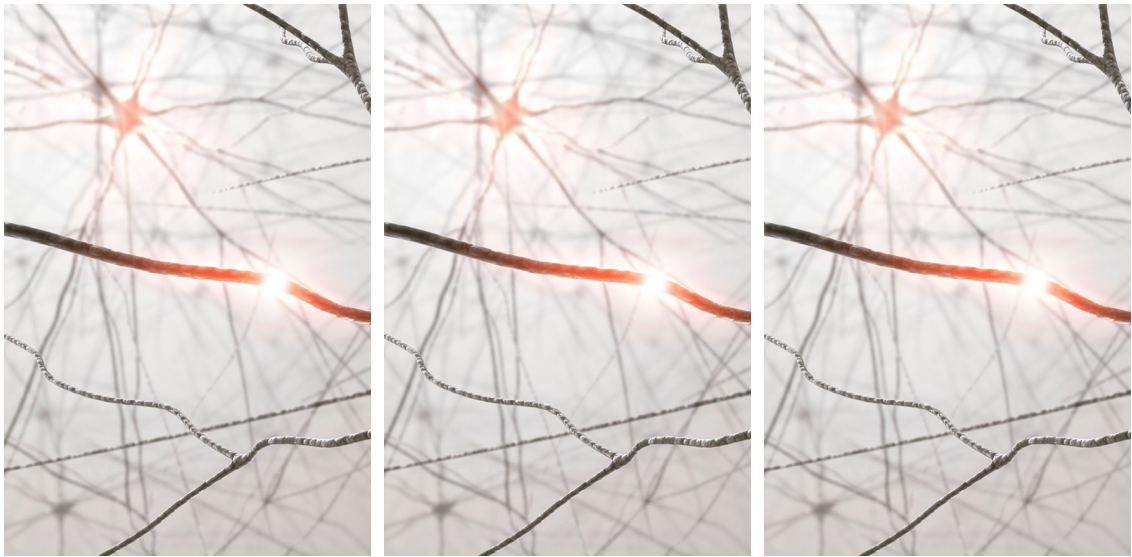
